#### WHAT DOES HACRO DO?

HACRO aims to educate and train and relieve poverty and sickness among people who are, or have been, in prison and their families. We promote study into and spread information about the prevention of crime. We work in partnership with other agencies and charities to prevent crime. Our work includes:

#### **SMALL GRANTS**

We help offenders on community orders and on licence with small items that make a difference when trying to get life back to normal, like some bedding or clothing, or help towards training.

#### MAKING PRISON VISITS LESS STRESSFUL

Our volunteers at HMP The Mount run the tea bar in the Visitors Centre; and help recruit and screen volunteers to work at the prison. In charity and business partnerships in the Visits Hall, HACRO runs the Children's Play Area; and manages accredited training courses for Baristas in the Coffee Bar (also at HMP Bedford).

#### **LEAVING PRISON BEHIND**

We run a programme of intensive work experience and vocational training in the local community to support prolific offenders in making the radical changes in their lifestyles to become crime free and ready for employment.

#### **CARING DADS**

We help fathers who have been abusive in their relationships to become more child oriented in their parenting.

#### **BUSINESS TUTORS**

Our volunteers on the Business Venture courses at HMP The Mount provide advice and research for men wanting to start their own business on release; and take part in a "Dragons' Den" sessions at the end of each course.

## ANNUAL CONFERENCE & REPORT & WEBSITE

We contribute to the debate on crime prevention issues like restorative justice, and employment and housing for ex-offenders. Our well attended Conferences attract civic leaders, representatives from the Police,

Probation, the Judiciary, local charities, as well as those interested in the criminal justice system. We publish an Annual Report and information is always available on our website www.hacro.org.uk
